6. How to get to the venue

We highly recommend public transport to come to the venue.

6.1. Public transit

The public transport (underground) in Vienna is available all night long between Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday (24h). Please consider that the ticket automats only take up to 10 EUR notes or coins.

There is a subway station very close to the venue. The station is one of the red line (U1). The station is called "Kaisermühlen VIC". You need to take the exit called "Donau-City-Straße/Austria Center Vienna".

Coming out of the underground station you will see a tobacco shop on the opposite side of the exit. There you can find our first guidepost. Follow them and you will get directly to the entrance of the tower.

6.2. Car

Please use a navigation system. Entering the exact address of the venue will bring you directly to the parking garage of the tower.

6.2.1. Parking/Attention

Parking outside of the parking garage is not possible anywhere near the tower. The cost of the parking garage is 25







EUR per day. The organizers offer a limited contingent of free parking tickets each day.

In case you need a free parking ticket on Saturday and/or Sunday please send an e-mail to info@royal78.com where you request such a ticket for 1 or 2 days. The deadline for these requests is the end of day Thursday 2nd of April. If tickets are available you will get a confirmation.

6.2.2. Taxi

There is a taxi rank close to the tower.

7. Arrival on Saturday

When you enter the Tech Gate Tower you have to take an elevator to the 19th floor.

Once arrived, in the "Welcome Area" you will find the registration desk, where you have to register and pay the starting fee. The tournament will start when all players are registered. Please make sure to register directly upon arrival, as we want to avoid a late start because of missing registrations.







8. Tournament on Saturday

8.1. Opening ceremony

Our special guests for the opening ceremony will be a representative of the 22^{nd} district.

8.2. Organization Information

8.2.1. Categories

Players are only allowed to play 1 category. An exception may be made for players of the categories U15 and U19.

8.2.2. Groups in individual categories

The tournament won't have groups of 3. In those categories where it is possible we will organize groups of 5 or even bigger but at minimum there will be 4 players in a group.

8.2.3. Draw

As long as it is possible, players from the same club and/or same country won't be in the same group. If it is not possible, then players from the same club or same country will play in the first round against each other.

8.2.4. Time Schedule

There will be an official tournament clock, which will be projected on a wall. This tournament clock is the only valid clock on the whole day. Generally there will be 10 minutes break from round to round, at half time the break will be 3 minutes.

All rounds for the groups in each category will be prepared on Saturday in the morning and can be viewed on published posters.







8.2.5. Referees

We won't have score sheets at the tables. You will find the schedule on posters on the wall. The referees must enter the final score of each match there.

If possible, players from the same club won't referee each other.

Players who get knocked out of the tournament have to stay for the following round since they may be asked to referee one last game.

It is possible that players are referees in other categories than the one they registered in.

8.2.6. Final group positions are determined as follows

- 1. Number of points won.
- 2. Result(s) of the direct match(es) between the players that have the same points.
- 3. Goal difference in the match(es) between the players that have the same points.
- 4. Most goals scored in the match(es) between the players that have the same points.
- 5. Total goal difference.
- 6. Most goals scored.
- 7. Shoot-out

8.2.7. Plate tournament / WASPA

Depending on the draw and the format we will organize a Plate tournament for players, who didn't make it out of their group. Information will be published at the tournament. Please let us know at the registration in the morning if you are interested to play the plate tournament.







8.3. Prize Giving Ceremony

There will be a prize giving ceremony on Saturday after the individual competitions. Our special guest for that ceremony will be a representative of the 22nd district of Vienna.

9. Tournament on Sunday

9.1. Organization Information

9.1.1. Groups in team categorie

The tournament won't have groups of 3 if possible.

9.1.2. Draw

As long as it is possible teams from the same club and/or same country won't be in the same group. If it is not possible, then teams from the same club or same country will play in the first round against each other.

9.1.3. Score Boards / Score Sheets

Score boards and Score Sheets will be used for the team competition.

9.1.4. Time Schedule

There will be an official tournament clock, which will be projected on a wall. This tournament clock is the only valid clock on the whole day. Generally there will be 15 minutes break from round to round, at half time the break will be 5 minutes at maximum.

All rounds for the groups in each category will be prepared on Saturday and can be viewed on the posters in the morning.







9.1.5. Referees

If possible, teams from the same club or country won't referee each other.

Teams who get knocked out of the tournament have to stay for the following round since they may be asked to referee one last game.

9.1.6. Final group positions are determined as follows

- 1. Number of points won.
- 2. Result(s) of the direct match(es) between the teams that have the same points.
- 3. Individual wins difference in the match(es) between the teams that have the same points.
- 4. Most individual wins achieved in the match(es) between the teams that have the same points.
- 5. Total individual wins difference.
- 6. Most individual wins achieved.
- 7. Goal difference in the match(es) between the teams that have the same points.
- 8. Most goals scored in the match(es) between the teams that have the same points.
- 9. Total goal difference.
- 10. Most goals scored.
- 11. Shoot-out

9.2. Prize Giving Ceremony

There will be a prize giving ceremony on Sunday after the team competition. Our special guests for that ceremony will be representatives of the 22nd district of Vienna.

11.1. Smoking
